- **3** For safe travels for those driving and flying to the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation in South Dakota for a week of camp for the Lakota children and teens
- 4 That we'll have a good week of weather during VBS
- 5 That God would prepare the hears of the Belize team to experience the presence of God as they minster
- 6 For the team from Alabama who will meet us in SD and help us run camp
- 7 For the preparation of all of our volunteers for VBS
- 8 For the health of the staff at Kings: Momma Leonie, Aunt Irene, Uncle Stanley (Stanley currently has colon cancer)
- 9 For the children attending VBS and that God will prepare their hearts to learn about Jesus
- 10 For physical and spiritual strength for our VBS leaders and children
- 11 That as the gospel is proclaimed that the enemy would be defeated
- 12 That the children at VBS hear the salvation message and they will come to an understanding of Jesus
- 13 For a great final day of VBS that will make a lasting impact on children and families
- 14 That God would bring families to MPBC from our VBS
- **15** For good daily camp attendance at Chanku Waste Ranch in South Dakota, and that God would prepare the hearts of the kids ahead of time
- 16 For a great number of VBS visitors at church this Sunday morning
- 17 That Jesus will become real to the unbelieving Lakota kids at camp and that they will make sincere decisions to follow the Jesus Way
- 18 That God would bless our VBS follow-up
- 19 That God would call members of the Belize team to missions
- 20 For good weather at camp, where extreme conditions are common, and that the bugs will not be a hindrance
- **21** For the full time missionary families living on the Reservation running Youth Evangelism Strategies: The Haddens, The Mouws, and the Homers
- **22** For travel and health for the Belize Team as we travel
- 23 That relationships at Kings Children's Home would begin to develop
- 24 That the kids at Kings Children's Home would hear about Jesus and find their identity in him
- 25 That the school being built at Kings Children's Home is coming along quickly
- 26 That there would be would be great gospel conversations as we do food distribution at night
- 27 For the parents of the kids that can't care for them at Kings due to prostitution, drugs, and alcohol
- 28 For an abundant presence of the Holy Spirit in each team member as they minister to the Lakota, safety for the bus drivers picking up kids daily, and no mechanical issues with the buses/vans
- **29** For each rotation at camp to be a blessing to the kids during the week, and for the team of folks preparing food for all the campers and staff each day
- **30** For the health of all the Lakota campers and the team members from VA and AL working together, and that everything done will be for God's glory
- **31** For the few Lakota believers living in the town of Manderson on the Pine Ridge Reservation, where there is a huge presence of drugs and gang violence
