

## WALK THROUGH SCRIPTURE: 2024 BIBLE READING PLAN

### Week of April 22-April 28

*We are now in the fourth week of Act 2, Scene 5 in the story of Scripture. This week we will slow down in our reading of David's story, but the narrative passages in days 3-4 are very important because they illustrate that in David's reign the true worship of the Lord took center stage. This week we will also read a number of psalms and finish the chronicler's genealogies. Allow the psalms to help you settle into a deeper worship of God. Although genealogies are not the most exciting reading in the Bible, continue to think about how they communicate the idea of identity for God's people.<sup>1</sup>*

**Sunday:** No Reading Plan Content Today – Come to Church!



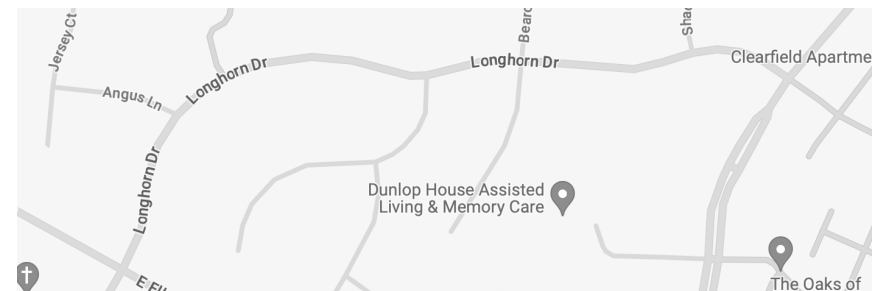
## WALK THROUGH SCRIPTURE: PRAYERWALKING GUIDE
